



## **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

### **TOURISM HEALTH MONITORING & RESPONSE SYSTEM (THMRS)**

#### **PHASE II**

**STANDARDS CONSULTANT:** Duration: 9 months

This consultant will be responsible for developing a core set of seven Caribbean-wide Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) “clean and green” Hospitality Standards, written in international standard and CARICOM format to improve health, safety and environmental quality in the hospitality sector.

**The specific responsibilities of the Standards Consultant will include but are not limited to:**

- Review the 2018 phase I consultancy report of the current national, regional and international hospitality health, food safety and environmental standards and guidelines
- Convene meeting with the Caribbean regional standards organisation for Quality (CROSQ), ABTA and ISO for the development of the seven Caribbean-wide Health, Safety and Environmental “clean and green” Hospitality Standards
- Develop core set of seven “clean and green” Regional hospitality health, safety & environment standards: Food safety, sewage treatment, energy management, solid waste management, integrated pest management and water testing and treatment
- Develop Framework for Implementation of the HSE standards
- Develop Criteria and Checklists for HSE standards; inclusive of scorecard
- Develop HSE standards accreditation/recognition criteria
- Develop database/framework for listing of accommodations implementing HSE standards for THMRS webpage
- Auger partnerships (with relevant contacts) for THMRS HSE standards recognition
- Convene Stakeholder Workshop for review and consensus on HSE Standards
- Review HSE standards following stakeholders’ workshop and format final document for Printing and Distributing in different formats
- Advises the Project Coordinator on Project-related operational planning and funding, policy matters and service delivery issues related to the establishment of the regional tourism health, food safety and environmental standards and guidelines

- Ensures timely submission of all Project work plans, budgets, periodic evaluations and reports according to donor formats as required
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

**Qualifications:**

A Bachelor of Science (BSc) or Bachelor of Arts (BA) degree from a recognized University and a Master's in hospitality management and public health.

**Experience:**

At least 3-5 years in a similar position.

Experience in working with the Caribbean Regional Standards Organisation for Quality (CROSQ) and developing regional hospitality standards will be an asset.
